

Underground Propane tank Owners

Has your Cathodic Protection (Anode bag) been tested on your underground propane tank in the past 3 years?

Every underground propane tank has at least (1) anode bag installed to help prevent corrosion at the time of installation.

Without proper protection, a tank is vulnerable to corrosion, which results into a possible leak.

According to the NFPA 58 LP-GAS codes, this MUST be done in intervals not to exceed 36 months.

Depending on your soil type, these anode bags could be consumed in as little as 6 years.

This is why there is a periodic test in place to make sure your underground propane tank will continue to be protected from corrosion and any unwanted leaks.
